### 4. Introduction of E-Payment in School Canteen and Bookstore – POSB Smart Buddy Programme

The POSB Smart Buddy Programme is the world's first in-school wearable tech programme to enable a contactless payment ecosystem that helps cultivate sensible saving and spending habits among children. Parents will be able to remotely manage your child's daily allowances, track their spending and savings, and set saving goals in a digital and interactive way using the Smart Buddy mobile app.

The school has been working closely with POSB and will be implementing the POSB Smart Buddy as an e-payment option in our school canteen and bookstore by end of Term 2. We will share more details with you via Parents Gateway (PG) nearer to the implementation period.
